



## APISLAVIA'S PLAN OF ACTIVITIES FOR 2009

1. By 30 November 2008 each member country shall submit to the Secretariat:
  - a. the plan of main events to be held in the country in 2009 - by dates;
  - b. the main economic incentives received by beekeepers annually; the main points in the long-term programs for promoting beekeeping development.

Responsible persons: Chairmen of National Unions/Associations

After summarizing the materials, the Secretariat shall send them to FIITEA (Bucharest) for publication on the Apislavia webpage.

2. To develop a draft plan of activities for the Commissions:
  - a. on the quality of beekeeping products; responsible: L. Gal
  - b. on cooperation with EU agencies; responsible: T. Sabat
  - c. on apitherapy; responsible: A. Paschenko
  - d. on direct contacts and exchange of experience: C. Constantinescu
  - e. on the system of promotional measures and awards for outstanding beekeepers, research workers and managers in the field of beekeeping; responsible: A. Butov

All these plans shall be reported by the commissions' chairmen to the Secretariat by the end of 2008. The Secretariat shall send them to all member countries before the end of January 2009.

3. To hold the meeting of Apislavia General Assembly in February-March 2009 with the following agenda:

- a. to discuss and approve the plans of activities for the Commissions;

- b. to approve the financial plan for 2009;
- c. to discuss the information on the condition of Apislavia webpage;  
Presenter: C. Constantinescu
- d. to discuss a draft program of the 18<sup>th</sup> Apislavia Congress  
Presenter: Apislavia President
- e. to approve the budget for 2009  
Presenter: Apislavia Secretary General
- f. to approve Apislavia's flag and emblem;  
Presenter: Apislavia Secretary General

A venue for the meeting of the General Assembly shall be decided by the Secretariat and communicated to all member countries before the end of 2008. At the meeting of the General Assembly the countries may propose some amendments and modifications to this plan.
